3. Attend the meeting in person.

### Some other helpful tips:

1. Try to register between 6:30pm and 7pm on the night of the meeting. Once the call for nominations starts the registration desk will be closed. The meeting officially starts at 7pm. Up-to-date membership lists of the riding and all surrounding ridings will be at the registration tables. Just in case, be sure to bring your membership card with you and some proof of where you live.
2. Free childcare support will be available at the First Unitarian Church during the meeting.
3. The First Unitarian Church of Hamilton is wheelchair accessible.
